

# HAND TOOLS

## LASTING PINCERS



The shoe industries number one lasting pincer. Corrugated jaws for a positive, non-slip "bite." Cross cut hammers are replaceable. Tack claw on lower handle.

No. 2 9/16" Wide 8-3/8" Long  
No. 4 11/16" Wide 10" Long

## LINING PINCER



A "Beaver Tail" pincer generally used for straightening counters, linings and uppers. Also used by saddlemakers. Specify plain or corrugated jaws when ordering. Overall length 6 inches.

## SHANK LASTER



Generally used on men's heavy boots. Jaws are fitted with teeth for a positive grip. Long wooden handle for leverage. Overall length 10 inches.

## TACK CUTTING NIPPER



Designed for cutting tack points protruding through insole. Curved to reach-into toe on all types of shoes. Made of high quality tool steel. Cuts flush, leaves no burrs. Overall length 13-1/2 inches.

## NAIL CUTTING NIPPER

Similar to the tack cutting nipper but with jaws designed and tempered to cut shoe nails. Does not cut as flush as the tack cutting nipper. Overall length 13-1/2".

## LASTING PINCER HAMMERS



Type C 3/4" Dia. 13/16" High  
Type E 1" Dia. 1-1/4" High

Type C is standard on the No. 2 Pincer  
Type E is standard on the No. 4 Pincer

## REVOLVING HEAD PUNCH



Revolving punch fitted with 6 different replaceable tubes. Overall length 8 inches.

## NO. 84 SHOEMAKERS FILE



An economical file used for sharpening awls or general factory tasks. Does not require a handle.

## EAGLE SHOE FILE



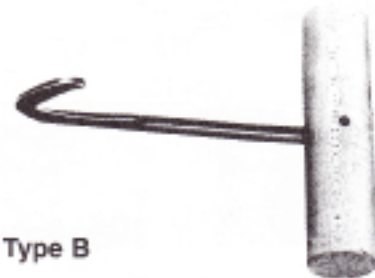
S-shaped for filing off hard-to-remove tacks or rough spots in the toe of the shoe.

## LACING THREAD CUTTERS
