

JARED HOLT WAXES

Stick Polish

This wax is applied to a shoe bottom after staining and filling with a covered brush and brought to a bright lustre by polishing with a hair brush. It is a medium soft wax which gives excellent fill and is easily brought to a bright finish.

Approx. 3 oz. round stick – 12/box

Carnauba Wax

Genuine, imported, 1st. quality carnauba wax molded into convenient 1/4 lb. cakes. This is one of the hardest natural waxes that produces a brilliant shine that is not easily smudged. It can be used to give the entire shoe a final polish but is almost a necessity after applying the above stick polish to the bottom.

Approx. 1/4 lb. cakes – 36/ctn.

Tip Top Finishing Wax

These waxes are used for edge padding and heel slicking operations.

Black, Brown, Neutral

1-½ x 2 x 5-½ cakes – approx. 40 lbs/ctn

Hi-Glo Finishing Wax

Similar to the Tip Top Finishing Wax but harder and will produce a higher lustre, but has less fill.

Black, Brown, Neutral

Approx. 1/4 lb. cakes – 144/ctn.

1-½ x 2 x 5-½ cakes – approx. 40 lbs/ctn

Abrasive Bars

These bars are a blend of a premium grade, micro-fine abrasive and a binder. Applied to a brush and then to the shoe or boot upper so that some of the color can be burnished off producing a brushed antique or Italian look. It is particularly useful in producing a hand burnished look on cowboy boots.

Black, Natural

Approx. 1 lb. cakes

Polishing Wax SW-1105

This wax contains a micro-fine abrasive and is sometimes used to level out the finishes on a shoe to produce a smooth surface. Usually followed with a final polishing using Supercera Bars. Neutral only.

Approx. 200 gram bars

Supercera Bars

These wax bars are used to give shoes a final polishing that looks and feels like a paste polishing, rather than a production line spray finished appearance. Generally applied to a yarn brush and then transferred to the shoe.

Black, Brown, Neutral

Approx. 1/2 lb. bars

Repair Crayons

We have developed literally hundreds of colors to match sample swatches but we are continually making new matches for new samples sent to us. In many cases all that is needed to salvage a scratched or nicked shoe is a quick touch-up with one of these crayons. Used primarily on shoes they also have an application in the furniture and automotive industry.

1 doz./box – 6 doz. minimum per color

Suede Powder

Color matched chalk powder used on suede leathers or fabrics. Rubbed in and then brushed out they can restore the original color and help to uniform the surface.

Quart Jars – 2 Qts. minimum per color

Paste Repairer

Thick, creamy paste with a high percentage of pigment for maximum coverage. Suitable for "finger method" repairing or spatula use. Intended for smooth leathers only. Compatible with most top finishes but trials should be made to ensure that there are no problems.

2 oz. jars – 6 jars minimum per color

Spray Repairer

Thin enough for use in spray repair guns these repairers still have plenty of pigment to ensure adequate coverage. Spray repairing is called for when it is difficult or impossible to blend in the repair area or the repair area is very large.

1 quart jars – 4 quarts minimum per color

Note: On all orders for new color matches of any of the above items, please submit a swatch no smaller than a dollar bill.

Magic Sticks

This is a thermoplastic wax with excellent adhesion and can be used to fill nicks or small holes in heels or edges and then finished in the usual way. Can be supplied in thin, crayon like sticks or in a capped cardboard tube.

Tip Wax

Tip Wax, as the name implies, is used for making repairs to the tip of the shoe or other areas that are near the sole line and not subject to flexing. The wax is fairly hard and will not withstand flexing without cracking.

Black and colors

Approx. 2 oz. tins
